

INFORMAL Subgroup Meeting Series

- experiments to be carried out next

Rules:

- Every scientist will be assigned to one of four subgroups.
- Semester and Master students are automatically in the subgroup of their direct supervisor.
- Every week (Thursdays, 9:30 AM), one of the four subgroups will be on.
- Everyone in the presenting subgroup will talk for **about 10 to 15 min**, which **always includes a brief introduction** to the project — even if we've seen it before!
- Presentations run from a computer (e.g. Powerpoint) are unacceptable. Encouraged is using the black board or (informal) overhead projection; suggestion: the youngest listed member in a group organizes the presenter device **...and: point to the screen!**
- Primary data must be at hand for possible evaluation/discussion.
- Attendance of **non-presenting** group members is **voluntary** but **welcome**, as any valuable input is appreciated.
